A Message from Our President Deborah Pauly, J.D.

Your Holiday "Down Time" Signals a Good Time for Dirty Dealings to Big Brother

There is no rest for the weary, my fellow patriots. When God-fearing, peace-loving citizens, like you and me, turn our thoughts toward the holiday season, the evil doers and government manipulators go into hyperdrive. They know our attentions will be diverted.

I've watched this occur repeatedly and at all levels of government. Highly controversial policies are pushed through, new outrageous public employ contracts are negotiated (sometimes even to be effective retroactively!) and other "public service" contracts are renewed or extended. This year is no different...except more people are paying attention, so government has had to be more slippery.

Cases in point: recent and pending actions by our "Republican-controlled" Orange County Board of Supervisors. The November 29, 2022 Board of Supervisors meeting contained two items of interest under the Health Care Agency. Item #34 which was "to approve continuation of local emergency... related to Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)" and Item #40 to "approve a contract with Composite Apps, Inc. for disease control and prevention health technologies enabled solutions."

Vaccine Passport Revived

You'll remember that the first step in locking down the state, the economy, our businesses and our families all started with the declaration of a health "emergency," so the concerns there are fairly obvious, but the Composite Apps contract sounds pretty innocuous. What is that? That's the Vaccine Passport for Orange County. That's right, folks. Show me your papers or you will be prohibited from participating. You can read about it and the supporting documents <u>here</u>.



According to the staff report, if the Board buys in, "This Contract will be 100 percent Federally funded through July 31, 2024, by the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity Coronavirus Response and Relief grant. HCA will re-evaluate funding and absorb costs after July 31, 2024, based on funding available at that time."

There is no such thing as free money from the federal government. It comes with strings attached. In the case of a Vaccine Passport, the strings are very dangerous and very long. (You'll remember CPOC's angst over Representative Young Kim supporting the Federal Vaccine Database. It's all part of the same program and is necessary for globalist population control and social credit system. Think China and the Communist Party because that is the source.)

No discussion. No explanation. Now, on the December 6 agenda, there is a deletion request from Chau for item #14. Do we trust that?

Feckless Party Leadership from Feckless Fred Whitaker

Fred Whitaker is Chairman of the Republican Party of Orange County. As such, he is CEO. I call him Feckless Fred. I've called him that for years and he knows it. I call him feckless because he is



feeble, futile and lacking initiative for the task at hand. However, he is excelling at using this position to feather his own nest.

It is preposterous, that the party CEO is pounding his chest over all the great "successes" that the Republican Party achieved this past election cycle. He has started lobbying and campaigning to remain chairman of the Orange County Republican Party, as new leadership is to be elected January 16, 2023. He's shameless.

Here are some of the "great" achievements we have seen in Orange County under

the leadership of Feckless Fred:

November 8, 2016 - Orange County votes Hillary Clinton, the first time The OC has voted for a Democrat in for president in 80 years! Why? Never-Trumpers at the helm gave a nod and wink and refused to encourage the party faithful to support our nominee, but instead bought into and echoed the national anti-Trump narrative of the mainstream media.

November 6, 2018 - All congressional races go Democrat. We lose every single Congressional seat. Why? Because there was wide scale ballot tampering with the mail ballot system. Irregularities were occurring everywhere. Many voters and political insiders were alarmed. These irregularities were reported to Feckless Fred. His response? "There is nothing we can do about it." August 6, 2019 - Orange County becomes a Democrat County as there are now officially more registered Democrats than Republicans. Why? It's because of the behind the scenes manipulations and the blind ambitions of Representative Michelle Steel and her husband Shawn (former CAGOP Chairman), who left that seat vacant without a care

as she moved on to bigger and better things for herself. The Steels actively worked to discourage the one person who could have won that seat. The Steels did nothing to help a potential Republican successor. They left Orange County in the lurch.

November 14, 2021 - Orange County fails to deliver on the recall of Gavin Newsom. Party leaders could not even muster a 50% YES vote. Yes, Fred was more than

happy to use Larry Elder, who was wildly popular with the base, to raise funds at the annual Flag Day Dinner in June 2021. It was incredibly selfish to divert Larry's attention from campaigning and raising funds for his own campaign. Mr. Elder is an honorable man, who has interfaced with and been embraced by the grassroots for many, many years. He's the only thing that gave this ill-fated recall any life. The entrenched party apparatus could have embraced him at any time during the previous 20 years.

November 8, 2022 - Democrats become majority on the Orange County Board of Supervisors. Orange County Republicans lose another Assemblyman. Why? Because the only thing that matters to the Steels is Michelle's seat in Congress. The only thing that matters to Fred is pleasing the Steels. Here's the sad truth: Given the actions of the "Republican board majority," it is likely we will not even be able to tell any difference once the Democrats are in the driver's seat.

November 29, 2022 - As of this date, there are 80,541 more registered Democrats than Republicans in Orange County. Why? Apathy and the official party turning a blind eye to the liberal voting records of our own elected Republicans.

Any CEO with this record of failure would have been fired over four years ago. Many concerned conservatives want to know how Fred can be replaced and who might be positioned to do it. Here are some facts that you need to understand. Only elected or appointed members currently sitting on the Central Committee may run for or be considered for executive board positions like Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.

There will not be another election for Central Committee until March 23, 2024. Shortly after Prop 14, which gave us the Top Two Jungle Primary, passed in 2010, the party leadership, under then-Chairman Scott Baugh, elected to move Central Committee races to a once every 4-year term, instead of a once every 2-year term as it always had been. So, the only bench from which to recruit a new and more effective Chairman would be from among those already on the committee. Unfortunately, those best qualified to lead are 100% on-board with the current leadership, such as it is. Fred is a very nice person and he does favors for all the right people.

CPOC's work now and through 2023 is all about 2024! Be part of the solution.

Bringing Together a Modern-Day Strategy Benefiting Faith, Families and Christianity

L t should come as no surprise to anyone that the United States of America was founded as a Christian nation. Protestant people, guilty of the unforgivable sin of seeking God in their own way, had fled Europe for the New World, and they brought their cherished faith with them. That faith taught humility, love for one's neighbors, and the importance of charity. These people were the earliest settlers of the land that would eventually become the US, and their spiritual traditions would inform and describe those of the first true Americans. They would also give rise to the practice of religious liberty that is so precious in our country today and as we fight for freedom.

One of the things everyone probably knows about the United States is the country's historical devotion to religious and spiritual values that have always formed the foundation of every institution. The founding fathers formed the constitution based on God's passionately held Christian beliefs that shaped our nation.

Many countries worldwide are trying to copy this timetested concept and, in fact, succeed in finding the same balance between secular institutionalism and the incorporation of spiritual values into all spheres of socio-political life. History, however, also knows violent and radical attempts to reestablish or entirely reform the religious foundation of a national idea, which traditionally leads to violent outbreaks and periods of terror and degradation. The Civil war is the main hallmark of this destabilization, which is woefully familiar to American history.

That is why those who would want to undermine the American state and its society would want to act by questioning the sacred foundations. And from what we see at the present time, those moves turn out more ineffective and threatening to the country, and its people than the most outrageous acts of aggression and terrorism on American soil.

There is a growing national religious political movement representing family, affairs of state, and religion, a modern-day inspiration by a myth of a group of rebellious clergies during the American Revolution who took up arms to lead their flock into battle against the British. The movement, imbued with support from far-right political activists like **Michael Flynn**, wants clerics to play a central role in not only preaching politics from the pulpit but also actively getting their congregations to rise to bring together with a modern-day strategy benefitting families, affairs of state and Christianity.

One man who understood this is the former Speaker of the House, Newt Gingrich. In his book "Rediscovering God in America", Gingrich confronts the sad, mistaken belief prevalent in this country today that the Founding Fathers were determined to banish God from all places in the American government. Isolated lines from the writings of these men are taken – often out of context – as "proof" that they envisioned a strictly secular government. For example, much is made of a letter written by Thomas Jefferson, in which he mentions a "wall of separation between Church and State". Gingrich clarifies that this is but a small part of Jefferson's story. Less often mentioned is the fact that our third President attended church services - in the US Capitol building. Jefferson too echoed the words " "Almighty God hath created the mind free. All attempts to influence it by temporary punishments or burthens...are a departure from the plan of the holy author of our religion." And the phrase penned by him: "Can the liberties of a nation be secure when we have removed a conviction that these liberties are the gift of God?"

The primary point of Gingrich's book is to discuss the nation's past, which speaks to the importance and indelible nature of its religious founding. George Washington, was a strong believer in the power of religion to generate political prosperity for a nation his monument bears the Latin inscription *"Laus Deo"*, or "Praise be to God". Abraham Lincoln's famous Gettysburg Address, reads: *"We here highly resolve that these dead shall not have died in vain, that this nation, under God, shall have a new birth of freedom."*

It is impossible to divorce the nation's founding from a deep faith in and reverence for God, and contrary to the misconceptions of some, to separate our Founding Fathers from those same beliefs. Our country was founded by people who personally knew religious domination of a style so completely eradicated by their courage as to be nearly unimaginable to a modern audience: They had seen a world in which Kings, Queens, and other powerful government officials might impose a particular set of religious beliefs on the populous, with dissenters being swiftly and severely punished. It is this brand of spiritual tyranny to elicit fear that our Founding Fathers sought to stamp out in the infant United States of America, not the notion – which would have been abhorrent to them and it is to many today – that faith in and of itself was an evil to be eschewed from government entirely.

Let's just imagine in the present day what our country could accomplish if we started working together as one unified people, under one God, saluting one flag.

The rise of Christian nationalism today represents in today's American politics that it has grown in recent years, parallel with the rise of *Trumpism* - The church has got to "return in its role as steward of liberty and government, our churches have fallen asleep much like its flocks that the "thousands of ecclesiastics" who subscribe to these particular views on the role of religion in American life, will "start the heart of this nation again and put it where it belongs: our heart with God."

This movement is an *informational spiritual warfare* persuasive speech that can inspire many people and with the midterm elections concluded, there is an opportunity for Christians to demonstrate their grassroots influence. <u>Christian nationalism beliefs</u> are increasingly the brand New Conservative Republican Party's political agenda, especially with abortion v. prolife, gender equity, racism, and the far-left agenda's race-class gender narrative teachings.



Pass the Turkey & Patriotism

Are you preparing for a Thanksgiving (or other) holiday feast where everyone has been told "not to discuss politics?" This year, America First MAGAs must stop being afraid to stand patriotically for faith, family, and country. Stop worrying that Progressives sitting at your table will attack you with a turkey leg. And what if they do get angry and don't talk to you? Maybe *you* shouldn't talk to *them*!

Throughout our history, Americans have

risked losing family, friends, and business partners when refusing to back down from their patriotic beliefs. But many of today's conservatives are afraid, even as progressives happily share their Marxist "the end justifies the means" views which often include election cheating.

Staying silent can no longer be an option. This is what Holocaust survivor Elie Wiesel (1928 – 2016) said about issues that affect a society's direction: *"We must take sides. Neutrality helps the oppressor, never the victim. Silence encourages the tormentor, never the tormented."*

In the 1770s, Colonial America debated whether to seek its independence from Great Britain or remain a colony. Families, friendships, and business relationships were torn apart. Founding Father Benjamin Franklin, who represented the colonies for several years while living in London, became a stalwart supporter of independence. His beloved son William was Governor of New Jersey and a steadfast supporter of the Crown. By 1776, <u>father and son were no</u> <u>longer communicating.</u> It broke both their hearts, but just as today, there are times when you must stand up for your beliefs.

In the 1850s, our young nation could no longer ignore the issue of slavery. Friendships were tattered. Northerners who rightly recognized the immense cruelty of slavery would no longer associate with Southern slave owners, even if the repercussions damaged long-time family, friend, and business associations.

Relationships also broke in the years leading up to the Second World War. On February 20, 1939, the German-American Bund, a popular pro-Nazi organization in the United States, held a massive rally in New York's Madison Square Gardens. More than 20,000 people celebrated George Washington's birthday with speakers standing on a stage that had American flags on one side and Nazi swastika flags on the other side.

By the early 1940s, Americans watched in horror weekly newsreels that showed Nazis destructively marching



across Europe. They saw gruesome scenes of atrocities against Jews as well as Christians who protested Third Reich policies. Once the United States entered the war, few patriotic Americans would share a Thanksgiving meal with family, friends, or business associates who supported Nazi Germany.

During the Vietnam War, during which 58,281 Americans died, how many Gold Star mothers prepared Thanksgiving dinners for guests who burned the American flag during protests and spit on those in uniform?

And what of Thanksgiving 2022?

This year, there might not even be much of a traditional Thanksgiving meal. With Bidenflation, the cost of the traditional dinner has skyrocketed, expected to rise 23 percent according to Wells Fargo analysts.

Instead of turkey, there might be Chef Boyardee. That's what Democrat Rep. Sean Patrick Maloney, chairman of the Democrat Congressional Campaign Committee, suggested on the November 6 *Meet the Press*. Maloney told Americans that if inflation is making it difficult to purchase both food for the family and gas for the car, to "eat more Chef Boyardee. So that's what families have to do."

Maloney lost his election two days later.

To those who say we must keep the lines of communication open, especially among family and friends, the response should be "pass the malarkey." Many Democrats seated at your table rabidly hate you and me. They mock our Judeo-Christian values including the right to life. They don't want the United States to be a beacon of freedom. They think we are stupid. As Sunny Hostin said on the *The View*, "What's also surprising to me is the abortion issue. I read a poll just yesterday that white Republican suburban women are now going to vote Republican. It's almost like roaches voting for Raid (roach spray), right?"

Ah, you just want a nice, happy Thanksgiving dinner. But while you are trying to enjoy the string bean casserole, your Progressive family and friends are trying to destroy the United States of America.

Maybe the compromise is to avoid politics during the main meal. Then when the pumpkin pie topped with whipped cream is served, casually mention why you give "thanks" to the Joe Biden administration including but not limited to:

- Rampant inflation (aka Bidenflation).
- Uncontrolled violent crime making it impossible to safely walk many city streets.
