We Are Being Overrun by Domestic Enemies of the Constitution Bring Reinforcements to Join Patriots in the Battle for Our Nation

Fresh from celebrating Biden's proclaimed "Transgender Day of Visibility" I am writing *Pauly's Perspective*. Today is April 1 (aka April Fools' Day), so you'd think we'd be celebrating the Transgender Day of Visibility today, but no....Biden proclaimed Easter Sunday, March 31 for that blasphemous distinction.

When I first heard about this, I could not believe it was true. Had Biden officially proclaimed Easter Sunday as Transgender Day of Visibility? I went to the official White House website. Here is the opening of the proclamation. You may read Biden's full Proclamation for yourself [here](#).

It is beyond outrageous!

Injustice

But wait, there's more: On Wednesday, March 27, the California State Bar recommended disbarment for one of the top Constitutional Law attorneys in the country. You can read all 128-pages of State Bar Court Judge Yvette Roland's Discussion and Order of Involuntary Inactive Enrollment against Dr. John Eastman [here](#).

Judge Roland pronounced that "after full consideration of the record," the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California had met its burden of proof on 10 of the 11 charges against Dr. Eastman. However, much of the evidence and expert testimony offered by Dr. Eastman's defense team was denied by Roland, so she could not have considered the full record. She did not want to consider the full record. Further, Roland went against Eastman on nearly every evidentiary objection made. At one point during the trial, she was actually making the State Bar's argument for it.

So much for an impartial and unbiased bench.

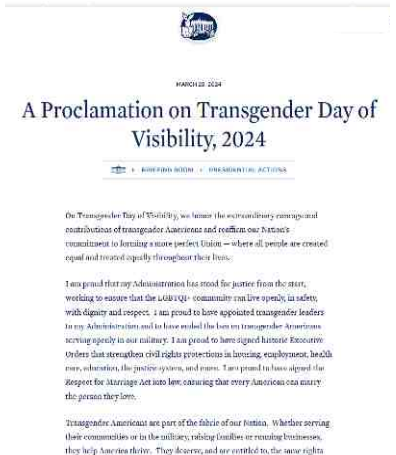

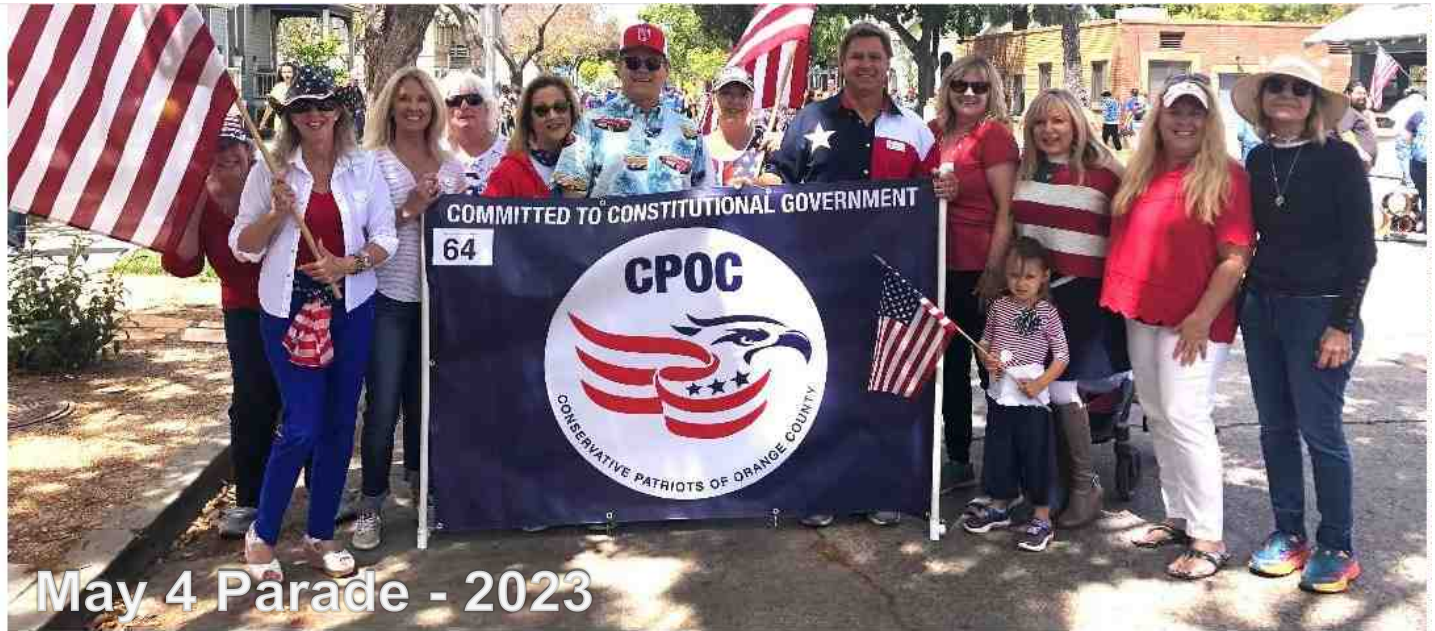
Social Media

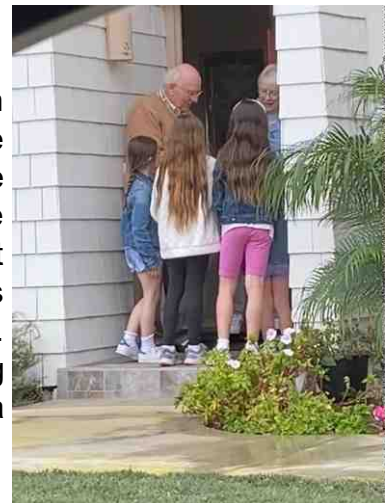
May 4 Parade

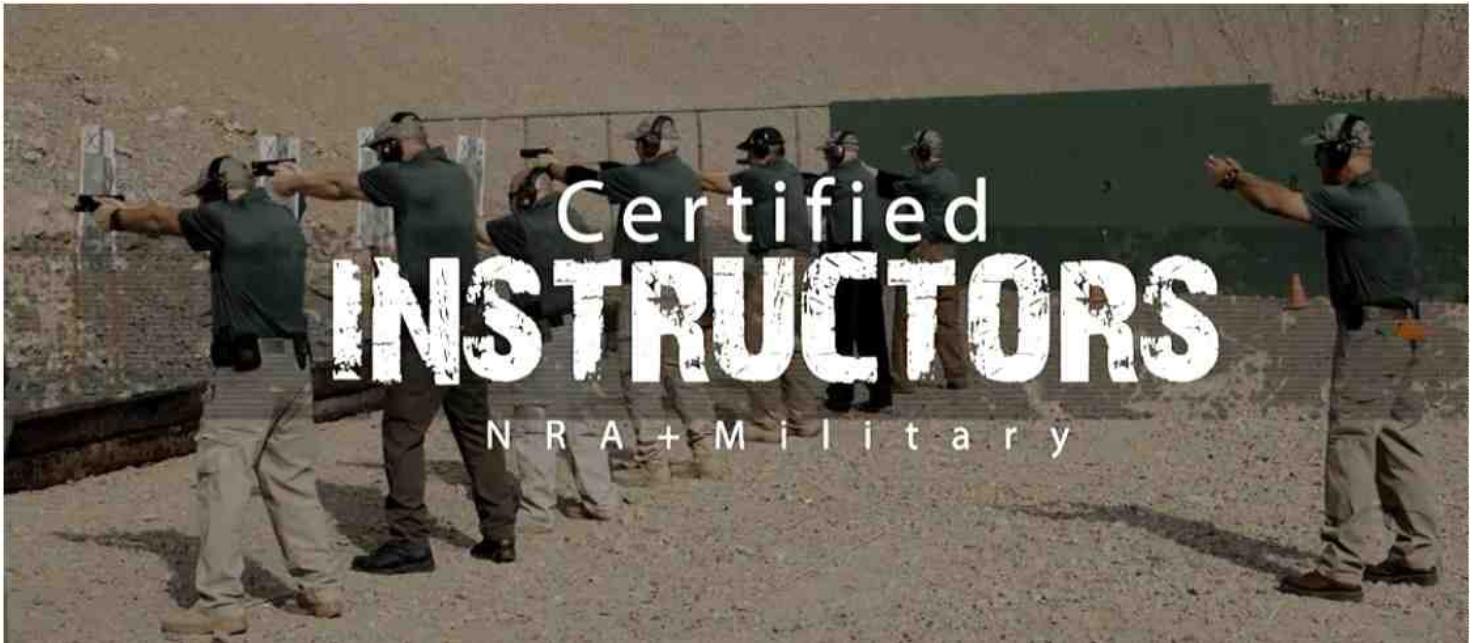
Firearms Day of Visibility

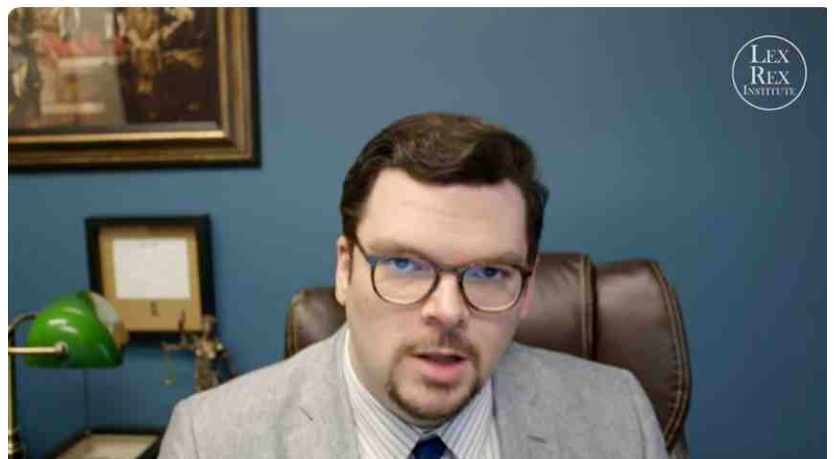

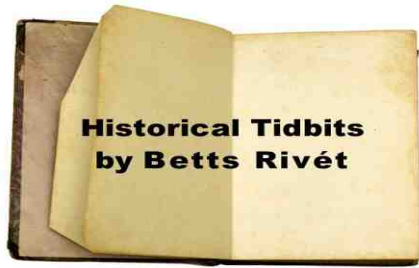

Surprising Facts About Thomas Jefferson

Oh yes, we all know that Thomas Jefferson was our third president holding that office for eight years (1801-1809) and that he wrote the Declaration of Independence. Jefferson was born on April 13, 1743 and lived 83 years. His cause of death was, of all things, chronic diarrhea. BUT here is more:



- He was obsessed with books, collected 6,487 books. He invented a rotating book holder that would hold 5 books so he could have 5 books going at the same time. A voracious reader! When the British burned all the books in the Library of Congress, Jefferson donated all of his personal books to help replace the lost books.
- He loved vanilla ice cream, He first tasted it in France, was given the recipe and made it for his family. That recipe is in the Library of Congress.
- He was homeschooled most of his life, entered the College of William and Mary at age 17.
- Jefferson was known as a quasi-archaeologist. During his first term, someone sent him the bones of a mastodon (40-million-year-old bones). Records tell us that he laid all the bones out in the East Room of the White House. Even though he had a second term as President, there are no records that say he finished putting the mastodon together.
- He kept mockingbirds. He loved their singing and usually had four at a time.



- We know that he designed his Monticello home. This name means “little mountain” in Italian. It took him 40 years to complete 33 rooms and four floors. Many rooms are octagonal because he loved that shape and there are many skylights. He wanted to bring the beauty of the outside in.
- Jefferson had 12 grandchildren; many of them lived with him. He organized races for the kids, taught them how to play chess and a game called Goose, a board game a bit like today’s game of Chutes and Ladders.
- He loved to draw. There is a logbook of his drawings of plants and animals that existed in the state of Virginia. He also wrote over 9,000 letters and used a polygraph machine to copy them. All preserved in the Library of Congress.
- Jefferson designed and began the University of Virginia.

Now you know a little bit more about Jefferson. On his grave is inscribed:

“Here is buried Thomas Jefferson, Author of the Declaration of Independence, of the Statute of Virginia for religious freedom and Father of the University of Virginia.”

He was a truly magnificent person who left an outstanding legacy. We are fortunate that the foundation of our country was built and crafted by people like Thomas Jefferson.

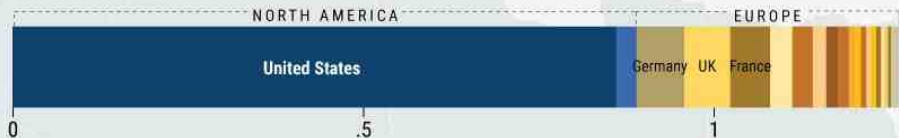
NATO Spending



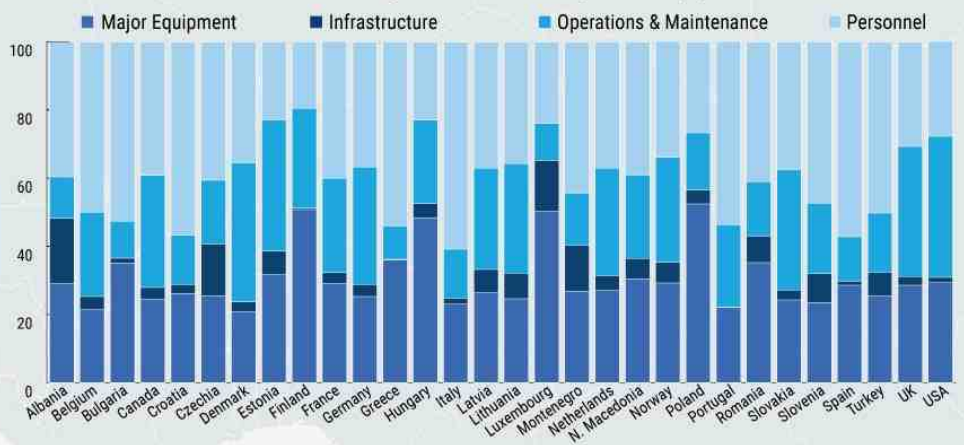
Defense expenditure as a share of GDP
