TRUMP WINS BIGLY!

**MAGA Movement Makes 2024 Presidential Election
Too Big to Rig**

Patriots took a giant collective sigh of relief Wednesday as our time of great national torment had finally ended. We passed the test. We survived the most intense election cycle any of us have ever experienced.

Across the board, we were exhausted from the emotional and psychological overload — a state of mental exhaustion — and it extended to those who are not normally engaged in the political process, but had determined to become involved out of great concern for the future of our Constitutional Republic, which appeared to be on the brink of being extinguished forever.

Patriots girded themselves against expected election shenanigans, a la 2020. The most frequently asked question that I fielded was what was the most secure way to cast ones ballot. My answer has never wavered: ***In Person, On Election Day, By Paper Ballot.***

Unless, a voter simply cannot vote in person because they are traveling, are physically incapacitated or deployed with the military, in person voting is the surest way to track your ballot and minimize — not eliminate — chain of custody issues. Absentee voting should be the exception, not the rule.

The second most frequently asked question I fielded was what to do if one had not receive a ballot by mail. This happened often, even though everyone was supposedly mailed a ballot. Entire households of “pure perfect” Republican voters never received their ballots in the mail, even though:

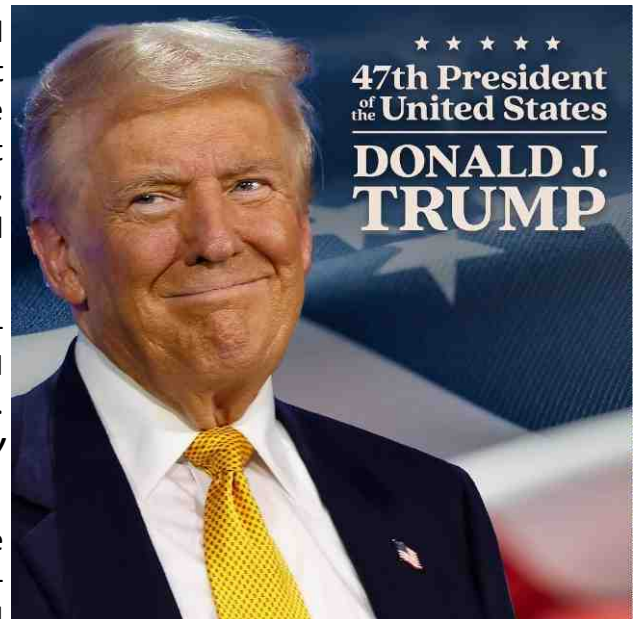
- 1) the Registrar showed that their ballots had been mailed to them;
- 2) they had not moved; and
- 3) they had never missed an election in the past four cycles — perfect voters, who were ACTIVE in the Orange County system.

Fortunately, we have had zero reports that someone else voted those undelivered ballots. Nonetheless, what happened to them?

What an ordeal we faced. Furthermore, in California, due to our dysfunctional elections process, the votes are still being counted with some critical races riding in the balance.

Make no mistake, Donald Trump's victory is **not** a victory for the Republican Party. In fact, it's a victory despite the Republican Party. Many in leadership positions are never-Trumpers and, underhandedly, worked against him behind the scenes.

How do I know this? The Republican Party was pushing early voting and they were pushing it hard. The OC GOP conducted ballot harvesting days and rallies and had posted daily tallies of how well Republican turnout was tracking when compared to Democrat turnout.

Those first results posted by the OC Registrar of Voters showed Trump was losing Orange County...again. These would be the early votes cast by party sycophants, who obediently do whatever they are told without question or thought.

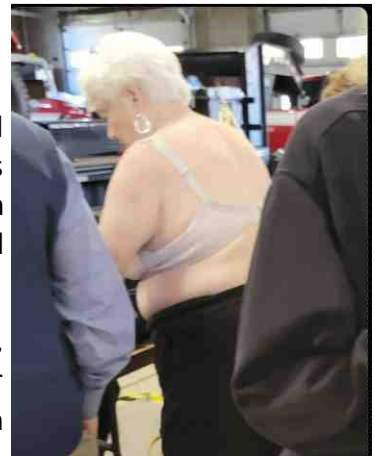
However, when vote center numbers were posted, Trump surged ahead. The lines at vote centers were longer than I had ever seen in the past. People waited in line an average of 1-1/2 hours in order to vote on Election Day.

Patriots no longer trust the US Postal Service for mail-in or drop box or early vote center processes, which are provisions of the Voters Choice Act (VCA) options that purportedly were designed to increase voter turnout. In fact, the VCA increased the entry points for irregularities and vote stealing. It has delaying the efficient and timely counting of ballots and reporting of results. The VCA has turned Election Day into a three to four-month-long Election Season. It is wearying.

The Patriot community largely chose to vote on Election Day.

I saw a meme last week asking what everyone was wearing to the Civil War. Several CPOC members decided to wear orange vests like garbage collectors or garments made from black trash bags when they voted. One New Jersey woman went viral when she defiantly stripped off her Trump shirt, flung it around in the air, and entered the polling place to vote in nothing but her unmentionable. I don't recommend it, but one has to admire her belligerent American spirit.
